- We have modified our schedule to 10am–3pm M-F so we can better limit the amount of staff and patients in our facility at any one time, helping our team and patients remain healthy but continue to provide compassionate, quality care.
- Dr. Reese is on-call and can take appointments via tele-health, feel free to set up your appointment via 719-488-9595.
- If you are out of contact lenses or have broken your glasses, we can almost always ship you a replacement with your non-expired measurements on file. Please leave a message at 719-488-9595 and we'll get back to you.
